#### WATER REDUCING AND RETARDING CONCRETE ADMIXTURE

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R is a water based, liquid, setretarding admixture that slows the chemical action of cement hydration, delaying the initial set in direct proportion to the dosage used. After the planned delay in initial set, hardening develops at an accelerated rate. Suitable for use in hot and tropical climatic conditions.

#### **USES**

Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R is used as a water reducing and set retarding admixture in structural and mass concrete where a controlled extension of setting time is required, such as:

- Large volume pours
- Avoidance of cold joints
- Construction joints without formwork
- Long hauls
- Difficult placing conditions
- Retarded mortars
- Slip formed concrete
- At elevated ambient temperatures

#### TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Concreting Guidance	The standard rules of good concreting practice for production and placing must be observed when using Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R in concrete. Refer to relevant standards. Fresh concrete must be cured properly especially at high temperatures in order to prevent plastic and drying shrinkage. Use Sika® Antisol® products as a curing agent or apply wet hessian.

#### APPLICATION INFORMATION

Recommended Dosage	0.1 - 0.25 % by weight of binder  Dosages by weight of binder outside this range can be used depending on the mix design, raw materials, climatic conditions and concrete requirements. Trial mixes must be performed to establish the exact dosage rate required.
Dispensing	Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R is added to the gauging water or simultaneously poured with it into the concrete mixer at the batching plant.  Do not add Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R directly to the dry mix.  The addition of the remaining gauging water (to fine tune concrete consistency) may only be started after two-thirds of the wet mixing time, to avoid surplus water in the concrete.
Compatibility	Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R is suitable for mixes containing all types of cement and supplementary cementitious materials such as: Microsilica (Silica Fume), Fly Ash (PFA), GGBS (Ground Granulated Blast Furnace Slag) and the following Sika products:  Sikament® SikaPlast® SikaPlast® Sika® ViscoCrete® SikaPump® SikaFerroGard® SikaFume® SikaFiber® SikaFiber® Sika® Stabilizer Sika® Stabilizer SikaControl® We recommend for trial mixes to be performed to establish the required performance when combining Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R with the above products or other admixtures. #### **BASIS OF PRODUCT DATA**

All technical data stated in this Product Data Sheet are based on laboratory tests. Actual measured data may vary due to circumstances beyond our control.

#### **LIMITATIONS**

Before pouring suitability tests on the fresh concrete must be carried out.

Due to the extended workability take special care that formwork is properly installed and secured.

If frozen and/or if precipitation has occurred, it may only be used after thawing slowly at room temperature and intensive mixing.

When using Sika® Plastiment® PZ 55 R a suitable concrete mix must be designed for the local material sources and trial mixes performed to verify suitability. Significant overdosing will result in increased workability and delayed setting time. During this period of ex-

tended setting time the concrete must be kept moist in order to prevent premature drying out. Under dosing will result in reduced workability and shorter setting times.
